This document is referred to as 'NM2' in the web search index [see note below]. An example of a reference such as NM2-R14G4 refers to the record below of the inscription on the memorial stone at grave location R14G4.

The records in this document cover the south east part of the graveyard, range 14 to 37, graves 1 to 44, appearing in blue on the cemetery plan. This document also includes the Garden of Remembrance graves ref GOR A1 to F23.

Names in this document are of people mentioned on memorials, not necessarily buried. Some people may be relatives of those buried. Some people are on more than one memorial.

The surname index for this document on the next page can assist in identifying a grave location for a particular surname.

Note that where a surname is not given on a memorial for someone with no burial record (i,e. a relative), we might assume a name that is a maidan name.

[Please note records in this document are not currently included in the web search index, compiling and verifying these records is in progress] This column contains transcriptions of the gravestones as they exist in July 2025.

There are several of the older flat grave stones that have become buried under several inches of soil over the last 100 years. These have been uncovered and recorded then reburied to preserve the stone from erosion and for safety of pedestrians.
